IN THE MATTER OF BNV ENERGY COMPANY LLC
FAILURE TO SUBMIT A SUBSEQUENT REPORT.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2-A-2020

BNV Energy Company LLC (BNV Energy) is the bonded operator of the BNV Eagle 1 well, API # 25-049-21110, located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T18N-R5W, Lewis and Clark County, Montana.

On May 10, 2018, the well was deepened. As required under ARM 36.22.1010, "within 30 days following completion of the well work, a subsequent report of the actual work performed must be submitted on Form No. 2." No subsequent report was received.

On January 14, 2019, September 3, 2019, and November 7, 2019, letters were mailed to BNV Energy requesting the required subsequent report. No response was received to these letters.

On January 14, 2020, a certified letter was sent with a February 12, 2020, deadline to submit the required subsequent report or the issue was going to be brought up at the Board Business meeting. No response was received to this letter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Board that BNV Energy must submit the subsequent report of the deepening of the BNV Eagle 1 well by March 26, 2020, hearing application deadline. Failure to submit the report by that date will result in BNV Energy being ordered to show cause at the April 30, 2020, public hearing, as to why penalties should not be imposed for failure to provide the required report.
